- 2. Clarice Female, 20-30. A young lover, daughter of Pantalone. Very self absorbed and not too bright.
- **3.** Dottore Male or Female, 40-60. The very proud and matchmaking father or mother of Sylvio. Dottore tries to appear smarter by constantly spouting facts and fancy information. The trouble is that most of these facts are nonsense.
- 4. Pantalone Male 40-60. Clarice's father. A miser, manipulator, and subject to emotional extremes.
- 5. Bob Male, 20-60. A large yet rightful porter.

Audition Requirements: You will be asked to do a cold read. We welcome you to prepare a one-two minute commedia monologue if you so desire. Vocal measuring will be included in the audition.

Auditions will start at 1 pm Sunday, April 24 and will be in order of arrival.
